Recruited and implemented a 24-hour package of support workers and therapists to assist with his complex care needs. Liaised with school therapy team and teachers for consistency in practice. Supported the management of the relocation project and supported with modifying the property to meet all his needs to live fulfilled life. Worked with the legal team throughout litigation and provided evidence reports to support his claim.
- Working with a teenager transitioning into adult, assisting in life choices alongside her family to ensure goals are being met. Working alongside professional therapist to ensure she has the best life opportunities and experiences alongside meeting her goals to live life to the full.
- Long term case management with a young lady with spinal cord injury and complex care needs. Managing a 24-hour care package and supervising the staff team. Supported her with researching many different places in the world to visit with accommodation and equipment to suit her needs. She has purchased her own property abroad.
