Working at AKA Case Management Limited to provide a collaborative service that assesses, plans, implements, monitors and evaluates support options and services that meet the unique needs of an individual who has suffered traumatic injury.

Examples of some of my current case load include:

- Long term case management with a man who has a brain injury and was in a residential unit for several years. He is now living independently at home with the help of a 24-hour support package. Duties include liaising with the CCG and social services to ensure the client receives funding and managing a team of 6 staff.
- Working with a lady with a through-the-knee amputation, integrating both NHS and private sector resources. Conducting multidisciplinary assessments to establish functional goals, including mobility, independence and pain management.
- Provide case management to a young lady who has cerebral palsy to live independently at home with her family. Manage a 24-hour package, supervising a team of 8 staff, liaise with the OT and Physio to ensure her goals are met. Work with the deputy to ensure the client's financial affairs are all in order.
- Long term case management with a young lady who has a spinal cord injury and complex care needs. Currently manage a full care package and supervise the staff team. Arrange many holidays for her, researching suitable accommodation to meet her needs and arrange equipment. Regular liaison with the NHS services and the spinal injury unit.
- Working with a male client with a leg amputation. This has been very rewarding as he is now walking with his prosthetic leg and is living independently. Supported the client with purchasing and adapting a suitable property.
- Working with a young boy with severe learning difficulties, supporting the family to ensure suitable accommodation for the client and liaising with the local authorities.

- Managing a 24-hour care package with a young lady with a brain injury to live independently in her own home.
- Provide case management for a 42 year old lady with a brain injury to support her to provide a stable and caring environment for her 11 year old. Part of this role involves liaising with his school to ensure his education needs are met at home as well as school.
- I am currently working with 2 young lads who were involved in a road traffic accident, to ensure their rehabilitation programme will give them the best start to regaining as much independence as possible.
- Experience with managing direct payments from social services and setting up managed accounts for clients.
