Examples of my current case load include:

- Working with a teenager transitioning into adult services and assisting in life choices with his family to ensure his goals are being met. Managing his support team ensuring he has life opportunities and support meeting his goals, by encouraging his cheeky character and personality in all choices.
- Working with an 11 year old girl following the finding of suitable accommodation with her parents and ensuring correct adaptations have been carried out within budget. Ensuring her EHCP is appropriate for her needs and liaising with statutory and private therapists to ensure correct rehabilitation. Ensuring she has time with her siblings and pets for play and development.
- Working with a teenager to achieve in college and promote his independence and confidence, progressing the setting up of an independent living trial. Ensuring his compliance with the rehabilitation team to reach his potential for the present and future. Assist the teenager and family through the appropriate statutory financial forms to obtain entitlements. Support the correct completion of an EHCP to ensure the required support is provided by the most suitable qualified professionals.
