Examples of my previous cases include:

- **Acquired and Traumatic Brain Injuries**  
I have experience working with clients with traumatic brain injury following road traffic accidents. One client had an employed support worker whom I managed, ensuring their supervision, mandatory training and other requirements were in place and regular audits were completed. I also have experience working with clients with acquired brain injury following having a stroke.
- **Amputation**  
I have worked with a client with a below knee diabetic amputation, ensuring his prosthesis was fit for purpose, getting appropriate rehabilitation in place for him and working with his support workers to ensure everyone worked together and towards the achievement of his goals.
- **Multi-Orthopaedic Trauma**  
I have gained experience working with various clients with multi-Orthopaedic trauma following road traffic collisions, including being hit by a car as a pedestrian, motorbike accident and accident that occurred whilst abroad. With these clients I have also managed rehabilitation budgets.
- **Spinal Injury, cancer & palliative care**  
When a client was diagnosed with terminal cancer and following spinal surgery was left without the use of her legs, I supported with getting her property adapted, sourcing an appropriate wheelchair and wheelchair accessible vehicle for her. I also supported the client and family through palliative and end-of-life care. A significant part of my role was to support communication between different people involved in her care.

Prior to working in case management, I worked within community persistent pain management supporting people with complex needs around their persistent pain. This included supporting with the impact of persistent pain on mental health, work, finances, social life, family life and physical limitations. I provided holistic assessments for clients considering all their needs, devised client-centred goals and supported in the journey of moving forwards in life with their pain. I also assessed clients for specialist pain procedures and did medication reviews. In this service I gained significant knowledge on complex needs and supporting clients in the rehabilitation journey.

Furthermore, I gained extensive experience both being a part of and leading the Multi-Disciplinary Team.

Prior to this, I worked in both NHS and private Musculoskeletal clinics and Orthopaedics.
